Reverend Darryl R. Burgan, Sr. serves as the Missions Pastor at First Baptist Church of Manassas, Virginia. In this capacity, he seeks God's Will and the direction of the Senior Servant in bringing mission opportunities to the Believers of Christ, to advance the Kingdom of God and in service to the body of Believers.
